New Business

Discussed 2022 Sergeant Promotional Testing Process. Chief Frake and Deputy Chief Mannino took input from Police Officers that took the Sergeant Promotional Test in 2019. It has become apparent that the content of the test, as well as the oral interview questions need to be updated to reflect current police work in McHenry County. They approached multiple testing agencies to inquire if a test for LITH Sergeant Promotional Testing could be customized starting in 2022. The Commission agreed with the idea and Chief Frake and Deputy Chief Mannino will come back to the next meeting on February 2 to discuss their findings.

Discussed 2022 Entry Level Testing process. Chairman DeSantis recommended that Commissioner Haugk take on the responsibility of the Entry Level process so that all three commissioners will have the experience of running the process from start to finish. Commissioner Lawson ran the process for 2020 during Covid. Commissioner Lawson will pass along the required information to Commissioner Haugk for coordination.
