CHAPTER 49 COMPREHENSIVE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT

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49.01 ADOPTION OF THE MCHENRY COUNTY STORMWATER MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE

The McHenry County Stormwater Management Ordinance is hereby adopted and amended as the Stormwater Management Ordinance of the Village of Lake in the Hills. Each and all of the provisions, penalties, conditions, and terms are hereby adopted and made part hereof as if fully set forth in this chapter.

49.02 AMENDMENTS

The McHenry County Stormwater Management Ordinance is subject to the following amendments:

A. Article VI.B.5.b.(2).i. of the McHenry County Stormwater Management Ordinance is amended to read as follows:

> i. 0.04 cubic feet per second per acre for the 2 year, 24 hour storm and 0.05 cubic feet per second per acre for the 100 year, 24 hour storm.

B. Article VI.B.5.c.(1).i. of the McHenry County Stormwater Management Ordinance is amended to read as follows:

> i. The Detention Volume vs. Percent Impervious chart in Appendix 6 for <u>stormwater management</u> <u>facilities</u> with a <u>tributary area</u> less than 10 acres, provided that the allowable release rates are 0.04 cubic feet per second per acre for the 2 year storm and 0.05 cubic feet per second for the 100 year storm; or

C. Article VI.B.5.d.(3).iv. of the McHenry County Stormwater Management Ordinance is amended to read as follows:

> i. The release rates shall be 0.04 cubic feet per second per acre of the total <u>tributary area</u> at the elevation created by impoundment of the required 2 year stormwater storage volume, and

0.05 cubic feet per second per acre of the total <u>tributary area</u> at the elevation created by the impoundment of the 100 year <u>stormwater storage</u> volume. The release rate and required <u>stormwater</u> <u>storage</u> volume shall be calculated using the 24hour storm. These standards may be modified by the <u>Enforcement Officer</u> to prevent an increase in the existing condition peak discharge rate or to prevent frequent overflow from the online detention facility.

D. Article VI.C.12.a.(2) of the McHenry County Stormwater Management Ordinance is amended to read as follows:

(2). The cumulative cost of two or more projects requiring a building permit or a <u>stormwater</u> <u>management permit</u> over a 10 year period equals or exceeds 50 percent of the market value of the <u>building</u> tracked on a percentage basis for each project.

E. Appendix 12: Definitions of the McHenry County Stormwater Management Ordinance is amended to read as follows:

> <u>oversight committee</u>: The Village Board of Trustees shall act as the <u>oversight committee</u> for the Village of Lake in the Hills.

> <u>substantial damage</u>: Damage of any origin sustained by a <u>building</u> in a <u>floodplain</u> whereby the cumulative percentage of damage during a 10 year period equals or exceeds 50 percent of the market value of the <u>building</u> before the damage occurred, regardless of actual repair work performed. The market value of volunteer labor and materials must be included in this determination.

> <u>substantial improvement</u>: Any repair, reconstruction, rehabilitation, addition, or other activity to a <u>building</u> or <u>floodplain</u> taking place during a 10 year period in which the cumulative project cost equals or exceeds 50 percent of the market value of the <u>building</u> before the improvement or repair was started.

49.03 Fees

A. MINOR DEVELOPMENT: \$250 flat fee.

B. <u>INTERMEDIATE</u> AND <u>MAJOR DEVELOPMENTS</u>: \$1,000 plus Reimbursement of Fees Agreement.

C. PUBLIC ROAD: No fee.
