Lake in the Hills Police Department announces Child Passenger Safety Week numbers

Lake in the Hills, IL – The Lake in the Hills Police Department announced the outcome of the recent traffic enforcement campaign conducted during National Child Passenger Safety Week. This initiative was designed to bolster the safety of our community's youngest members by enforcing traffic laws, deter traffic violations that put child passengers at risk and bring community awareness to traffic laws that help to protect child passengers.

Officers made an additional 53 traffic stops during the campaign period. These stops resulted in 12 speeding, 15 seat belt, and 11 distracted driving (electronic communication device) citations. Further citations and arrests were made for:
