Child transported to hospital after being found unresponsive in pond

Lake in the Hills, IL – On Friday, July 23, 2021, at approximately 12:35pm, officers were dispatched to the 0-100 Block of Point O Woods Ct. in Lake in the Hills for a missing male juvenile who had reportedly wandered away from his home. Officers immediately responded to the location to begin searching for the missing child.

Golfers in the Boulder Ridge Country Club neighborhood located the child unresponsive in a nearby pond, pulled him out, and began to initiate CPR. Upon arrival, first responders took over life saving measures. The child was transported by ambulance to Northwestern Medicine Huntley Hospital by the Huntley Fire Protection District. He was later transferred via helicopter to Ann & Robert H. Lurie Children's Hospital of Chicago. The child's current condition is unknown at this time.

This is an ongoing investigation and information will be forthcoming as it is available.
