Lake in the Hills Police Department Announces Independence Day Traffic Enforcement Campaign Results

Lake in the Hills, IL – From June 17th through July 6th, the Lake in the Hills Police Department joined forces with state and local police agencies as part of the Independence Day enforcement campaign in an effort to make travel safer. During this time, 32.25 hours of additional patrols were conducted through a grant obtained from the Illinois Department of Transportation's Sustained Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP).

Throughout the mobilization, officers performed 43 traffic stops for various violations including:

- 18 seat belt citations
- One citation issued for failure to secure child in a seat belt
- 15 speeding citations
- Six uninsured motorists
- One citation issued for operating motor vehicle while using an electronic communications device

Additionally, two arrests were made and both individuals were charged with Driving While License Suspended. One of the drivers was also charged with suspended registration, while the other failed to wear a seat belt.

This mobilization was funded by federal traffic safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation as part of the statewide *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over* and *Click It or Ticket* programs.
