Lake in the Hills Police Department Releases Holiday *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over* Enforcement Campaign Results

Lake in the Hills, IL – The Lake in the Hills Police Department partnered with the U.S. Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration for the 2019 holiday season *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over* drunk-driving enforcement campaign. From December 16, 2019, through January 2, 2020, officers worked an extra 23 hours of enforcement in an effort to keep alcohol and drug impaired drivers off the roadways.

During this mobilization, the Lake in the Hills Police Department issued 25 total citations. Officers stopped 27 vehicles for violations of the Illinois Vehicle Code (IVC). Among these violations, one (1) citation was issued for a violation of Scott's Law, one (1) citation was issued for distracted driving, two (2) drivers were cited for no insurance, two (2) drivers were cited for expired registration, and 19 drivers were cited for speeding violations. The Traffic Unit is pleased to report they did not observe any drivers under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

This mobilization was made possible by federal highway safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation.
