Register Now for Free Women's Safety Series

Lake in the Hills, IL – This fall, the Lake in the Hills Police Department will present a free three-week intensive program that addresses many threats and safety challenges women face in today's environments. Topics include: defensive tactics, social scene safety, social media safety, suicide prevention, domestic violence, alcohol and drugs, sexual assault and stalking. Instruction will be provided by members of the Lake in the Hills Police Department and featured guest speakers. Classes will be held on October 9th, 16^{th} and 23^{rd} from 6pm - 9pm at the Irv Floress Safety Education Center (1109 Crystal Lake Road).

Participants will learn to defend themselves with confidence in this interactive program which provides training in recognizing potentially dangerous situations, as well as techniques for defending against attacks. These three, 3-hour classes are perfect for women going to college, who live and travel alone and for anyone interested in learning new skills and information.

For females 17+ years of age (sensitive material). Space is limited, and pre-registration is required. Priority registration will be given to Lake in the Hills residents; non-residents also welcome.
