Lawn Sprinkler Project Sheet

Submit a completed and building permit application and plat of survey showing sprinkler head and RPZ locations.

Applications are available at the Village Hall and on the Village's website using the link below:

A copy of the RPZ Certification must be attached to the RPZ device at time of installation.

Heads or piping is not allowed in any easement.

Your contractor must be licensed by the Village before your permit can be issued.

Once the permit is issued, the permit will be valid for 2 months. A final RPZ certified report needs to be forwarded to the Village Hall prior to permit expiration.

Please submit your building permit application, with all attachments, to the Village Hall via or U.S. mail, walk in, or after-hours drop box located at the parking lot entrance. Or it can be emailed to cd@lith.org. No money is due at submittal time. We will contact you if more information is needed or when the permit is ready. We can arrange for online permit payment and to email the approved permit back to you.

Please allow approximately 10 business days after submitting your drawing and application for the review process. Once issued, the permit will be valid for two months.
