Lake in the Hills Police Department releases Independence Day enforcement numbers *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over, Drive High Get a DUI*

Lake in the Hills, IL – The Lake in the Hills Police Department joined forces with more than 200 other state and local law enforcement agencies to get drunk and drugged drivers off our roads, encourage seat belt use, and enforce speeding and other traffic laws. The effort featured high-visibility enforcement combined with a variety of outreach activities including the “It’s Not a Game” media campaign.

During the campaign, the Lake in the Hills Police Department conducted sixty-seven (67) total traffic stops, issuing forty-two (42) total citations.
