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Applications Sought for Planning and Zoning Commission Vacancy

Lake in the Hills, IL—The Village of Lake in the Hills is seeking applicants to fill a vacancy on the Planning and Zoning Commission. Applications will be reviewed as they are received.

The Planning and Zoning Commission reviews applications regarding variances, zoning amendments, conditional use permits, and planned unit developments and appeals to decisions made by the Director of Community Development.

“Members of the Planning and Zoning Commission play a critical role in shaping the economic and physical landscape of Lake in the Hills,” said Village President Ray Bogdanowski.

“Residents with a strong interest in public service and community development are encouraged to apply.”

The commission is also responsible for reviewing subdivision plats and development plans. Based on their review and discussion, members make recommendations related to community development to the Village Board of Trustees.

The commission meets on the Monday following the second Thursday of every month. The meetings start at 7:30 p.m. and are open to the public.

Village President Ray Bogdanowski will review applications and candidates to fill the vacancy. The Village President appoints all commission members with the advice and consent of the Village Board.
