Those present were Members Wackerlin, Cairns, Sivakumar, Andrea, Anderson, Sandage and Chairwoman Tredore. Also present were Assistant Director of Parks & Recreation Megan Sandven, Recreation Supervisor Kristi Brewer, Recreation Coordinator Michelle Steffey and Customer Service Specialist Megan Schnaebeler.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

STAFF REPORTS

Assistant Director Sandven opened the discussion with information regarding budgeted equipment replacements which includes the playgrounds at Horner Park, Echo Park, Edward Hynes Park and the Richard Taylor Skate Park. Sandven noted that information will be released regarding focus groups and the procedures will likely follow those of previous years. Furthermore, Sandven commented that in addition to the playground equipment, a few of the Thor Guard Lightning Detection Systems will be replaced. Assistant Director Sandven informed the board that the People for Parks Foundation donated funds to provide a coach bus for the Eataly Senior Trip that will occur in February. Coordinator Steffey added that the senior group was very excited and looking forward to this trip. Assistant Director Sandven stated that the Ice Fishing Derby has been rescheduled for Saturday, February 15th and ice conditions are being monitored daily. Sandven concluded the staff reports by announcing that her last day with the Village of Lake in the Hills will be Friday, February 7th.

- A. Holiday Lights Contest Award Presentation:** Assistant Director Sandven began the award presentation with an overview of the activity. Sandven stated that there were three full bus tours this year. Sandven indicated that winners were offered a choice between a trophy or gift card. Sandven stated that some winners chose gift cards and were not present but two winners opted to receive a trophy. Coordinator Steffey presented the Strathmann family with the Show Stopper trophy and the Hachmeister Family with the New Kid on the Block trophy.

SUBJECT: 2020 Playground and Skate Park Replacements

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This year, the Village plans to replace the existing skate park equipment at Richard Taylor Park and the existing playground equipment at Horner Park, Echo Park, and Edward Hynes Park. In January, Village staff released a Request For Simplified Proposals requesting replacement design concept plans and through this process, Village staff received three design concept plans for the Richard Taylor Skate Park and six design concepts for each of the playgrounds. After these initial design concept plans were received, Village staff released a survey in February requesting resident feedback on the initial design concept plans. After reviewing the survey results (Attachment 1), one desired feature that was repeatedly mentioned in the survey was a zip-line. As such, Village staff contacted the playground vendors at the end of February, provided them with a copy of the survey results and gave them the option of adding one or more design concept plans or replacing one or more of their design concept plans. The playground vendors responded by providing Village staff with eight additional design concept plans, which are highlighted in orange below.

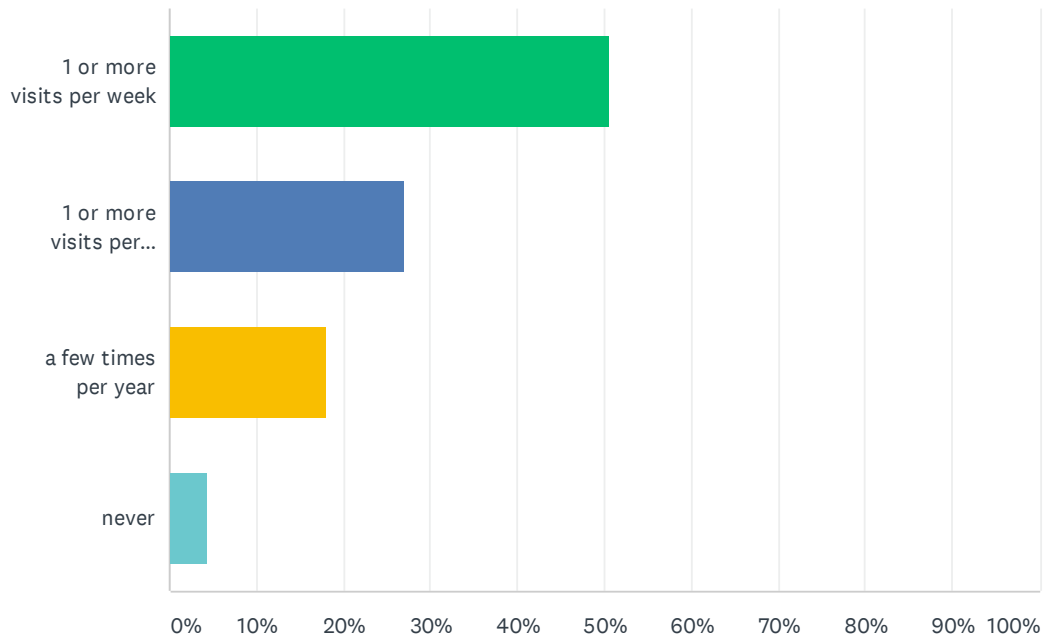

Recreation Project Status

Staff continues to set up the new Community Pass software. Program registrations, including Bark Park and Preschool are being taken in the new software. Facility Reservation setup is ongoing and more details will be presented in the April report.

Preschool Academy registration for the 2020-2021 school year began in February. Current registration is at 45 students (53 students in 2019; 49 students in 2018).

Preschool Academy held Dr. Seuss Night for participants and families on Wednesday, February 19th. Teachers from each classroom showcased student artwork related to a Dr. Seuss book, themed snacks and Dr. Seuss books were read aloud by teachers, staff members and the Preschool Academy Mascot-Captain. Over 50 participants attended. Previous years, this event was held as a world culture night or as a student art show.

Daddy Daughter Date Day and Night events were held on Saturday, February 22nd. At the daytime event, 65 participants attended and enjoyed games, crafts, activities, bingo, dancing and desserts. There were 161 participants at the evening event for dessert, activities, music and dancing. The evening event had a wait list of 24. Total participation for the event was 226 (182 participants in 2019; 231 participants in 2018). Event overview will be presented in April.

AARP Tax Appointments are made for low to moderate income individuals, age 50 and older living in the McHenry County area at no charge. 12 appointments are held every Monday and Friday at Village Hall (February 3- April 10). At this time, appointments in February and March are 90% filled.

Spring Break Camp is planned for March 23-27 at Village Hall. Camp will run daily from 7am – 6pm with a field trip each day. Trips include AMC Movie, Round 1 Arcade, Discovery Center Museum, Medieval Times and indoor swimming at the Centre of Elgin.

FuntastiCamp Program: The summer camp brochure is currently being designed and will be available beginning of April. Registration is online only through CommunityPass.

Seasonal staff positions for summer, including Supervisor, Program Leaders and Counselors are posted. Applications must be completed online. Preschool Assistant Teacher position remains open. Division staff is developing a recreation internship position for summer 2020.
